BOA Grand Nationals

It's hard to believe that the Bands of America Grand National Championships is into its fourth decade of service to music educational excellence, but this glorious Finals night was the 30th to take place. The night got off to a rousing start with a performance of the "Star Spangled Banner" by the Indianapolis Public Schools All-City Marching Band, accompanied by the Stephenson High School "Sonic Sound" Marching Band from Atlanta, Georgia that had entertained the audience in exhibition Friday night.

1st place - Highest General Effect

With nine open pyramids scattered across the field over tarps of symbols encountered in the journey through life, Carmel HS (IN) performed the original music of "Suspended Symbols," by director Richard Saucedo. A double entendre in title, a variety of cymbals were fastened to the pyramids and performed antiphonally from the far reaches of the field. Sort of a symphonic jazz suite, the music achieved a sense of contemporary immediacy without sounding urgent, somewhat laid back but yet propelling through space with an eagerness to get wherever it was going. This resulted in some intense build-ups into exciting quantum releases of jazz energy, woodwind fingers flying casually across the keys while the brass stepped in to push the music to a dynamic climax. The music wound down while the guard came forward to sit in a peace symbol, leading one to pontificate on the symbols as imagery for our past, present and future.

2nd place - Grand National Class AAA Champion, Outstanding Music Performance

Ronald Reagan HS (TX) delicately segued from an ever-building warm-up directly into a subtle opening statement of relaxed contentment interrupted by a spectacular demonstration of woodwind pyrotechnics. "You Never Know" was comprised of Leonard Bernstein's "Profanation" and Hindemith's "Symphonic Metamorphosis," with original music by Aaron Guidry serving as a sort of cosmic glue. The melodies were tweaked, kneaded and shaped into a totally fresh take on the two classics, with elements of Dave Brubeck's "Blue Rondo ala Turk" somehow sneaking in and grabbing some air time. Giant streamers bursting forth from the arms of the twirling guard members added to the constant element of musical surprise. Instead of an anticipated big ending, the band gently wafted to the lower right corner of the field, where an oozing soft chord placed a comforting blanket over the production and allowed all to tuck themselves in and say, "ahhhhh."

3rd place

L.D. Bell HS (TX) "Ascension: Light of Gold" combined DiLorenzo's "A Little Russian Circus," Higdon's "Blue Cathedral" and "Concerto for Orchestra," Newman's "Angels in America" and Whitacre's "Lux Aurumque (Light of Gold)" into a spiritually renewing montage that was cosmically evocative and spiritually stimulating from its serendipitous beginning to its hopeful end. An otherworldly serenity permeated the production throughout; the guard could easily have been visions of angelic splendor with long flowing flags and billowing lavender dresses. Comforting strains of beautiful woodwinds and middle to low brass chorale-like thoughts were followed by all being siphoned into the upper right corner by some unforeseen force as the guard, enveloped in flowing fabric, rose at the end to offer a brief glimpse of some heavenly vision not quite decipherable by mere mortals, at least in this lifetime.

4th place - Outstanding Visual Performance

Pulsating like a rapidly throbbing heart off-the-line, Eric Whitacre's "Equus," as delivered by Avon HS (IN), slowly pounded a rhythmic stake into the souls of the audience. Somewhat tender in nature but constantly prodding, searching for something unforeseen and unannounced, the piece captivated one with its relentless drive towards its undetermined destination with fate. A wide variety of brave and large image dead-on block drill swirls demonstrated why the band captured the visual honors in semifinals and finals. A heroic but controlled stampede to the front of the field led one to believe the show might be over, but the persistent rhythmic pulse returned to push the

band to the outer reaches of the field, away from any easy resolution... while putting an indelible musical and mystical stamp on the show that the search for whatever is out there in our universe continues on past the end of the show and into eternity.

5th place

Few bands' uniform colors were more appropriate to a show concept than the gray and black worn by Lawrence Central HS (IN), serving as a visual point of departure in "Shadows and Light," the band proper providing the shadows and the rich creamy colors of and in the guard providing the light. The Russian piano stylings woven throughout the entire show commenced in Mvt. I "Sihouettes" with drill forms reflecting off one another as if each curve was a shadow of its neighboring curve. An eruption of pastels in Mvt. II "Refraction" tricked the eyes that had become accustomed to watching the production in black and white. Mvt. III "Speed of Light" climaxed with a brief statement of Andrew Lloyd Weber's "Unexpected Song" before returning to the previously scheduled program, reminding us that shadows sometimes take on personalities that can disappear at the smallest introduction of light thrown on the subject.

6th place

Haunting and able to shake the soul to its primal essence, the disquieting sounds of "Impressions in Black Granite," as performed by Marian Catholic HS (IL) to Elliot Goldenthal's "Vietnam Oratorio," drafted one right out of their seat into the conflict musically portrayed on the field. There were no casual observers. This was a show that cut a wound into the psyche with a bayonet of hard-edged drill maneuvers and napalm-rich melodic brutality, enveloping one in the turmoil with no way out but to fight for one's personal survival and hope the world as one knew it would still be the same when one was released by the unseen enemy. A constant use of black versus white uniform pants created many visual battles of interlocking combative forms. At the end, the five black backdrops came together to form the Vietnam Wall, inscribed with the names of Illinois veterans who never made it home, as a final soft woodwind statement seemed to ask the eternal question, "Why?"

7th place

The unforgiving optimism of "Inside Out" by Richland HS (TX) traced the origins and evolution of the human spirit through its sometimes-cantankerous and pessimistic youthful development, leading us towards a life that is to be full of hope and promise. "Aloft" by Jack Stamp, Michael Daugherty's "Bells for Stokowski," "Incantation from Cirque de Soliel" and "Quidam" by Jutras Benoit, "Sleep" by Eric Whitacre and Mark Higginbotham's "Inside Out" contributed oft-angst-filled moments that always resolved positively to let one know things would turn out okay, that life is worth the hassles one must experience as one passes through it's occasional difficulties. Along the way, there were also some genuinely tender expressions of trust that were could bring a tear to one's eye. As the announcer stated in his final pronouncement, "In life, we all must learn to celebrate, and to celebrate ourselves, from the inside out."

8th Place - Grand National Class AA Champion

"Pathways" of Tarpon Springs HS (TX) featured original music by Frank Sullivan and Kevin Ford, divided into the following segments; Mvt. I "Exploration," Mvt. II "Service," "Mvt. III "Courage," Mvt. IV "Sacrifice," Mvt. V "Greed" and Mvt. VI "Innovation." The show focused on the paths we all must choose as we travel through life, and hopefully we will choose well... for ourselves as well as the world at large. The music often featured finger-busting runs and subtle color nuances that added an aural patina of wonder for the ears. A tribute to Rosa Parks was on the field well before her recent passing. Giant dollar flags filled the field during the menacing drive of "Greed," which threatened to undo the good done by humans in the prior movements, but ultimately, we learned that we all have the capacity to use our lives for good, reminded that the path we choose makes all the difference in our own lives and those of others.

9th place

Plymouth-Canton Education Park (MI) explored the concept of "Performing Inside Out" to music of Steve Reich, Michael Nyman, Christopher Rouse and Frank Ticheli. The bloodstream almost flowed backwards during the pulse music in Mvt. I "Control." Mvt. II "Breath" soothed things over with a lovely chorale, with Mvt. III "Tension" not actually tipping things over, but letting one know the unpredictable was about to spin the show off into a different direction. Mvt. IV "Chaos" threw a dissonant assemblage of contrary music assaults across the field as the structure rapidly disintegrated into musical anarchy, with Mvt. V "Release" re-establishing serenity like a strong musical tranquilizer. Mvt. VI "Structure" announced that order had been restored and was once again in charge, with the band triumphantly making its strong peacekeeping presence known on what could have been a field of musical discontent.

10th place

Drifting out of a jazz club and onto the field, "Blue Light Red Light (Someone's There)" of Harry Connick, Jr. and Ramsey McLean announced that Centerville HS (OH) was in town jamming with the best of traveling artists. "BLUESprint" was a set of jazz tunes containing something for all dedicated jazz aficionados. "Second Draft" by Andrew Markworth, based on Dave Brubeck's "Blue Rondo ala Turk" blew the accumulated smoke right out the front door with its gale force intensity and drive. Like a torch song belted out by a jazz diva sitting on the edge of a grand piano, the sultry alto flute solo in "Blue" by Joni Mitchell reached out and wrapped its arms around those in the audience, its plaintive wailing undoubtedly causing some to reach deep into their pockets for

the tip jar. "Sprint" by Andrew Markworth" ended the jazz set with a finger-snapping rollick of feel-good vibrancy that shook all out of complacency for the figurative drive home.

11th place

Center Grove HS (IN) offered up a "Conspiracy Theory" of its own with a crime "whodunit," pitting agents of the FBI against the altered natures of themselves. Crime files floated across the field on the winds of drama as one attempted to figure out if the flag-waving agents were truly friends of the country or were simply out for their own interests. Excerpts from "Sing, Sing, J. Edgar Hoover," "Goop," "Nightmare" and "The Hands of Fate, Parts 1 and 2" presented alternating images of patriotic do-gooder scenes with censored text on the flags as other guard members emptied the file cabinets in an apparent attempt to destroy evidence. The show seemed to let us make up our own minds about who were the heroes and who were the villains, considering that perhaps they were one and the same... a somewhat dark assessment on those who have sworn to protect us along with the interests of their own country.

12th place

The fluorescent bright plumage on the guard gave away the "Fowl Play" theme of Owasso HS (OK), with similarly colored flags spun like the proudest of peacocks strutting their stuff. Hints of Stravinsky's "The Firebird" developed into fuller segments suggesting the nobility of our fine-feathered friends, but that vision of fowl finery was paved over by an impish dance set that instead focused on a little humor from the guard as the winds spun flags of many avian colors. Bird sounds from the winds and a "did I really hear that" proclamation of "AFLAC!" let us know now to take this birding experience too seriously. Another stab at "Firebird" wound the show down as the guard flapped its collective wings and attempted to fly off to places unknown except to the wanderlust desires of those small members of our world that might be more full of thoughts than one would expect from bird-brained entities.

Class A Champion exhibition

Adair County HS (KY) opened up the field band part of the evening with "Evolutions," a spirited program building on the essential elements of music. Mvt. I "Rhythm" snuck unto the field and built up some primal steam, exploring the role of rhythm in composition. The solemn Mvt. II "Melody" served as a lovely bridge to the lively Mvt. III. "Dynamics," exploring the upper dynamic range that one would normally not expect from a smaller band. All elements were put together for Mvt. IV, a stirring rendition of Samuel Barber's "Medea," with a velocity seldom attempted by many larger bands.

In the finals finale, the Al Castronova Espirit de Corps Award went to the band that BOA staff thought represented the best elements of sportsmanship among all bands at Grand Nationals. It was awarded to Thousand Oaks HS (CA).
