Required Rehearsal Materials: Winds

The following materials are required by the *first rehearsal after memorial day* to participate in rehearsal. These materials may be purchased wherever you would like, and do not have to be a certain brand or color (with the exception of the black towel). For accessibility, links have been provided to assist in location of each item.







<p><u>1-Gallon Water Bottle</u></p> <p>This must be a one gallon jug. We have found that a half-gallon jug is not sufficient for outside rehearsals in the sun. It is recommended that the student's name is written on the bottle as well. These can be found at local sporting goods stores or online.</p>	
<p><u>Music Binder with Page Protectors</u></p> <p>Students are recommended to use a zip-up binder in the event that it rains. Sheet protectors are required to hold the music in place. It is recommended to use "anti-glare" sheet protectors so that music is still readable while rehearsing outside.</p>	
<p><u>Breathing Tube</u></p> <p>Used during music rehearsals. This is technically called a compact ball valve, and can be found at Lowes or Home Depot. They often have a black or red valve - the color does not make a difference. Please be sure to purchase the correct size for your instrument.</p> <p>1/2 Inch Tube - Flutes, Clarinets, Trumpets, Mellophones 3/4 Inch Tube - Saxes, Bass Clarinets, Trombones, Baritones 1 inch Tube- Tubas</p>	
<p><u>Pencils</u></p> <p>All students are required to have pencils at every rehearsal. It does not matter if they are mechanical or not.</p>	
<p><u>Black Towel</u></p> <p>These towels are used to protect the instruments as they are set down on the ground during rehearsal. These towels must be dark black.</p> <p>Hand Towel - Flutes, Clarinets, Saxophones, Trumpets, Mellphones, Baritones Regular Sized Towel - Bass Clarinets, Tenor Sax, Bari Sax, Trombone, Tuba</p>	
<p><u>Other:</u></p> <p>Hats and/or Sunglasses - To protect students from sunburn (as well as their lips) Athletic Clothes - Students must be able to perform physical activities. (No Jeans) Athletic Shoes - Students should wear athletic shoes to perform physical activities in. Woodwinds - 2-3 Reeds at all times Brass - Valve Oil</p>

Required Rehearsal Materials: Guard

The following materials are required by the *first rehearsal after memorial day* to participate in rehearsal. These materials may be purchased wherever you would like, and do not have to be a certain brand or color. For accessibility, links have been provided to assist in location of each item.

<p><u>1-Gallon Water Bottle</u></p> <p>This must be a one gallon jug. We have found that a half-gallon jug is not sufficient for outside rehearsals in the sun. It is recommended that the student's name is written on the bottle as well. These can be found at local sporting goods stores or online.</p>	
<p><u>Athletic Shoes</u></p> <p>Athletic shoes are imperative to the success and safety of the members to be able to perform what is asked of them without injury to their feet. Converse or Vans are not acceptable, as they do not provide proper support to the feet.</p>	
<p><u>Athletic Clothing</u></p> <p>Similar to the category above, the proper clothing is important to the success of the student. This means clothing they can move in that won't restrict any type of movement the member will be asked to do.</p> <p>Optional: spandex shorts to wear underneath your shorts while stretching</p>	
<p><u>Pencils</u></p> <p>All students are required to have pencils at every rehearsal. It does not matter if they are mechanical or not.</p>	
<p><u>Beach Towel</u></p> <p>These are used to stretch on when we are outside. No one loves to lay in the mud after it rains, protect your clothes and stretch on your towel.</p>	
<p><u>Hair Ties or Pins</u></p> <p>Hair needs to be completely out of the face when at rehearsal. When the members are spinning and tossing equipment into the air it is important their vision isn't obstructed by their hair.</p>

Required Rehearsal Materials: Percussion

The following materials are required by the *first rehearsal after memorial day* to participate in rehearsal. These materials may be purchased wherever you would like, and do not have to be a certain brand or color. For accessibility, clickable links have been provided to assist in the location of each item.

<p><u>1-Gallon Water Bottle</u></p> <p>This must be a one gallon jug. We have found that a half-gallon jug is not sufficient for outside rehearsals in the sun. It is recommended that the student's name is written on the bottle as well. These can be found at local sporting goods stores or online.</p>	
<p><u>Music Binder with Page Protectors</u></p> <p>Students are recommended to use at least a 1" binder. Sheet protectors are required to hold the music in place. It is recommended to use "anti-glare" sheet protectors so that music is still readable while rehearsing outside.</p>	
<p><u>Pencils</u></p> <p>All students are required to have pencils at every rehearsal. It does not matter if they are mechanical or not.</p>	
<p><u>Highlighted Parts (BD only)</u></p> <p>Bass Drum students are required to have their parts highlighted by the next rehearsal after receiving them.</p>	
<p><u>Small Notepad (FE only)</u></p> <p>Front Ensemble students are required to have a small notepad in order to take notes throughout rehearsals.</p>	
<p><u>Headphones (FE only)</u></p> <p>Front Ensemble students are required to have a pair of headphones that work with their cell phones. iPhone 7 users need to make sure they are not trying to borrow from others. Dollar store headphones work great for this.</p>	
<p><u>Other:</u></p> <p>Hats and/or Sunglasses - To protect students from sunburn (as well as their lips)</p> <p>Athletic Clothes - Students must be able to perform physical activities. (No Jeans)</p> <p>Athletic Shoes - Students should wear athletic shoes to perform physical activities in.</p> <p>Battery - 1 pair of <u>unbroken</u> drumsticks or bass drum mallets</p>
